
Trocaire

Virtual Dementia Café

Nenagh and Ballina-Killaloe are joining forces for the month of July to host their first Virtual Dementia Café.

Join us at our inaugural Virtual Café on Tuesday 13th July 2021 at 11am with your cup of tea as we hear from Aifric Devane, our speaker for this month. This event will be hosted online via Zoom by Silver Arch Family Resource Centre in Nenagh and Killaloe-Ballina Family Resource Centre, with the support of the Irish Dementia Café Network.

Aifric is a candidate Advanced Nurse Practitioner and Public Health Nurse, in addition to having a Postgrad in Dementia and is a Dementia Champion, and has many years of experience supporting people whose lives have been affected by dementia.
