The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary




The Colours of Mary's Clothes: The Virgin Mother

Mary is wearing a red tunic and a dark blue mantle. We are told that red was the colour worn by virgins in the time of Jesus, and the dark blue of the mantle was the colour worn by mothers. These colours are pointing up Mary, the Virgin Mother. The title 'Virgin Mother' emphasises the central mystery of Christian faith that Christ has only one father in heaven and so is true God, while having a human mother on earth and so is truly human. As our creed says, Jesus was conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary'. From as far back as the early second century the virginity of Mary is

found in the writings of the Church Fathers, people like St. Ignatius of Antioch who was martyred in 110AD. It originated in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. It is not just an honorary title; it is a fact: Mary was the means that God used to smuggle his Son into the world. And when the artist painted Mary's clothes in red and dark blue they intended to reinforce and reflect on this teaching of the Church and this belief of all the faithful.
