Re-opening Nenagh Parish...together again!

Ireland has entered a new phase in the relaxation of pandemic restrictions, and the Nenagh Parish COVID-19 Management Group is delighted to announce what these changes mean for public worship in St Mary of the Rosary church. (Announcements on St John's will come in advance of re-opening). The following guidelines apply from 1 November 2021:

- Face Coverings **remain a requirement** within the church buildings.

While public communal worship is now open to greater numbers than before, the two centre aisles will be reserved for those members of our parish community who wish to continue social distancing. **In the two centre aisles, therefore, social distancing will remain in place.**

- Mass-goers are asked to continue to approach for Holy Communion from the centre aisle and return by the side aisles.
 - Communicants receive Holy Communion on the hand **only**.
- Holy Water fonts will remain empty, however, you can continue to collect Holy Water from the tap outside the Sacristy for use in your home.
- The Sacrament of Confession will be celebrated under the current arrangement and the monthly Reconciliation Ceremony will continue.
- Collections will be taken up at entrance doors using sealed containers, before and after each weekend Mass.
- Sanitisation of the Church after Mass and other gatherings will continue until further notice.

Nenagh Parish thanks all our wonderful Volunteer Stewards and Sanitising Teams, as well as the Eucharistic Ministers and Readers, for their outstanding and continued service to our Parish Community during challenging times!

The 26th UN Climate Conference (or COP26 for short) begins this week in Glasgow and will go on until 12 November. Pope Francis, along with other religious leaders has called on those attending COP26 to renew their commitment to keep global temperatures below 1.5°C and to take action to make this possible. We are asked to pray for the success of COP26 during these days.
