

Beatification of Pauline Jaricot one of Missio's founders on this Sunday May 22 in Lyon, France. Pauline established a penny collection in her local area in 1822 the first social missionary network. Supporters met in small groups to donate pennies, pray and exchange news about the missions. This network became the Society for the Propagation of the faith on 3 May 1822.
