Collection Box St Mary of the Rosary

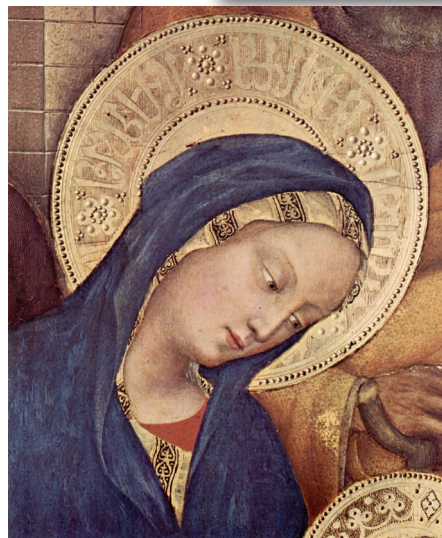
