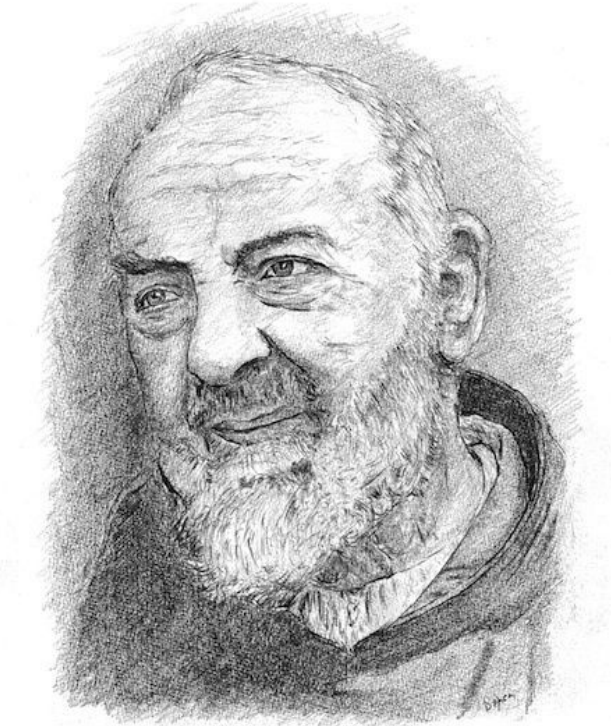

FEAST OF ST PADRE PIO 23 September



St Padre Pio

Feast Day - 23 September

Born into an Italian peasant farming family on May 25, 1887, Padre Pio was a humble Capuchin priest who lived the last 50 years of his life in a remote part of the Gargano Mountains, in a small town called San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy. He was blessed by God in many outstanding and mysterious ways. He is the only priest in Catholic history to bear in his body the Stigmata, the five wounds of Jesus Christ Crucified.

God also blessed Padre Pio with the gifts of miraculous cures, bilocation, prophecy, conversion, perfume and the reading of souls. People are still experiencing healings today through his intercession in ways that cannot be explained by medicine or science.

Just as impressive and important as the physical cures are the spiritual healings experienced by people throughout the world who place their prayers, hopes and troubles in Padre Pio's heavenly care. Beyond a doubt, Padre Pio is a powerful intercessor for us before Almighty God.

Padre Pio had prophesied countless things during his lifetime, including his own death, nine years before it happened, to the exact day. Seeing that moment coming, he got up from his bed, put on his

Capuchin Franciscan habit, offered his last confession, sat down in a chair and whispered, "I see two mothers!" An hour later he was in Heaven. His passing was calm and peaceful.

Alongside the chair, on a little table, are the things that were in his Capuchin habit when he died: a relic of the True Cross which he always carried on his person, and religious medals that he would give to the faithful as he walked through the crowds. There were also a few little white mints someone had given him that were still in a pocket of his habit.

Terribly weakened and completely exhausted by years of serious illness and the physical effects of the Stigmata, Padre Pio died of a heart attack in the Friary in San Giovanni Rotondo on September 23, 1968. After his death, many were eager for the Church to begin the process of studying Padre Pio's life, convinced that one day he would be canonized a Saint of the Catholic Church. At an outdoor Mass in St. Peter's Square in Vatican City, Padre Pio was beatified and declared "Blessed" by Pope John Paul II on May 2, 1999. Just three years later, on June 16, 2002, Padre Pio was canonized a Saint by Pope John Paul II, again in St. Peter's Square, at the largest gathering ever recorded in the history of the city of Rome.
