As we awake this Easter morn we know the joy of those who came to the tomb on that first day of the week, that first Sunday. The Lord is truly risen, Alleluia. Having set out on the journey of the Easter Triduum we arise this morning and welcome the light of life.



The Power of "Nothing"

On this Easter, we are reminded that the Resurrection of Jesus Christ changes everything. In the Gospel, John runs to the empty tomb, looks in, and sees... nothing. Yet this "nothing" proclaims the greatest truth: Jesus has conquered sin and death. The empty tomb is not a sign of absence but a declaration of victory. It speaks to the transformative power of faith - a risky hope rooted not in blind belief but in the concrete reality of Jesus' life, death, and Resurrection.

Like John, we are invited to look at the empty places in our lives and believe that God is at work. The same power that raised Jesus from the dead is present, offering us new life, forgiveness, and freedom. In our darkest moments, when it seems like nothing is there, we can remember that God's silence is often the prelude to his most profound works. Easter reminds us that even "nothing" can reveal everything.

John saw 'nothing' in the tomb yet believed. how can you develop the spiritual practice of trusting in God's presence, even when it feels like he is silent or absent?

The Resurrection demonstrates that God transforms even the greatest tragedies. How might this truth shape how you view your own struggles or losses?

The empty tomb is a sign of victory over sin and death. What steps can you take to live more fully in the freedom and new life Christ offers?

'Christ is alive! He is our hope, and in a wonderful way he brings youth to our world. Everything he touches becomes young, new, full of life ... Christ is alive and he wants you to be alive! He is in you, he is with you and he never abandons you.
